Re: Invitation to assist with teaching the Paediatric Neurology Module for the BSc PCH students

As you are aware, The College of Medicine is conducting a three years degree course for mature clinical officers to specialize in paediatrics and child health. After their graduation they will be based in their home district to improve the paediatric care at the hospitals and to strengthen the child health programs together with the various program managers.

Paediatric neurology is part of the teaching program for these students and we would like to invite you to assist with teaching this block for these students, like you have done last year. Your contribution was much appreciated. This year the 2 week block has been scheduled for the period starting Monday 30 April and closing 11 May 2018. During these 2 weeks the students will receive a number of lectures during the afternoon and bedside teaching sessions during the morning ward rounds in the different wards. The Thursday afternoons are not available for teaching sessions, as the students are presenting general cases to the different consultants. As last year, you will be part of some of the visits to the students who are doing their junior district attachment.

Besides the bachelor students there will be interns and third years medical students doing their junior clinical rotation. Also, these 2 groups should be included in the teaching program.
